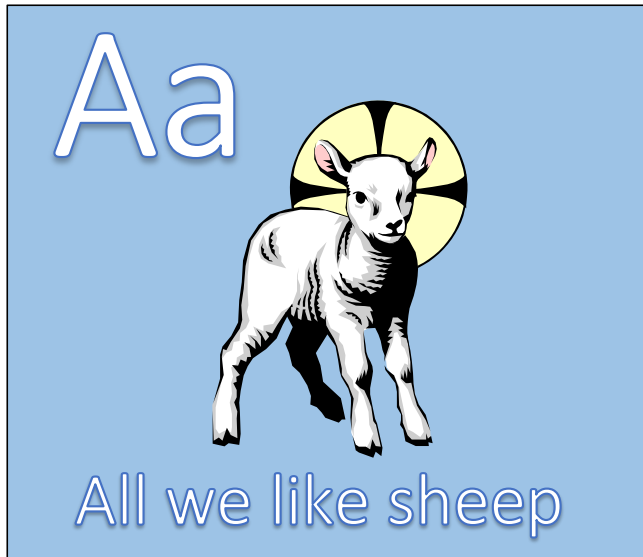

Cut out the picture above and put it on a ring with flash cards you will add as you learn the verses A-Z. Read aloud Isaiah 53: 1-12

Read again verse 6

**“All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned, every one, to his own way; and the Lord has laid on him (Jesus) the iniquity of us all.” Isaiah 53:6**

Discuss with your children what the verses mean. Ask them:

Have you ever seen sheep grazing in a field, or pictures of sheep grazing? Did you know that their shepherd takes care of them? The shepherd makes sure that if a sheep wanders off, or goes astray, he does everything he can to bring the sheep back home safely.

God is comparing us to the sheep, because sometimes we wander away from the safety of the Shepherd. When we sin and don't obey God, we are going astray. God sent his Son, Jesus, to pay for our sins. When Jesus died on the cross for us, He paid the price for our iniquity – our sin. That's how much He loves us. Jesus paid the price.

When we accept the gift of salvation – Jesus wipes our sins away, we are brought into the Shepherd's fold. I want to do my best to stay close to the Good Shepherd, how about you?

Let's pray together:

“Dear Lord Jesus, thank you for loving us so much. We want to do our best and not go astray. Please help us today as we learn and grow, to act the way you want us to. We thank you Lord for taking good care of us, we thank you for keeping us close. Amen.”

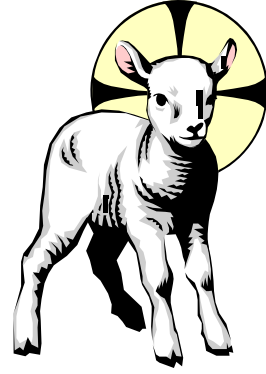
